What do I need to pack for a nursery session?

We always find the weather this term can be quite unpredictable. On hot sunny days can you please apply suncream at home before coming to nursery. We are happy to re-apply throughout the day – please ensure bottles are clearly labelled with your child's name. We do have a small supply of sun hats for children who forget to bring their own.

We will be using the outdoor area everyday so could you please avoid sending your child in jellies, open toed sandals, or flip-flops. Trainers, pumps etc will enable children to fully participate in activities such as climbing or riding balance bikes/trikes.

Please could you provide a full change of clothes, wellies, and slippers for each session.

If your child is in nappies/pull ups, please provide enough for each session, wet wipes, and nappy sacks.
