Y2	Locational Knowledge	Use world maps, atlases and globes.
Y2	Locational Knowledge	Use simple compass directions.

Y2	Human and Physical Geography	<i>Explore the weather and climate in the UK and around the world.</i> Locate hot and cold areas of the world in relation to the Equator and the North and South Poles.

	Human and Physical Geography	Use basic geographical vocabulary to refer to: Key physical features including: Mountain, ocean, river, soil, valley, vegetation Key human features including: Village, factory, farm, house, office, shop.
Y2	Geographical Skills and fieldwork	Use world maps, atlases and globes to identify the countries, continents and oceans studied during the year.
Y2	Geographical Skills and fieldwork	Use compass directions north, south, east and west and locational language e.g. near, far, left, right to describe the location of features and routes on a map.
Y2	Geographical Skills and fieldwork	Use aerial images and plan perspectives to recognise landmarks and basic human and physical features.
