



### Communication and Language

We will be using vocabulary related to the seaside, pirates and underwater habitats.

We will be thinking about the emotion of Jealousy and how that can make our bodies feel.

We will be encouraging children to shift their attention when playing and develop their ability to stop and look when asked.

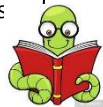
### Physical Development

The children this term will be developing their fine motor control by picking up pom poms with a peg, constructing with octons, playing with multi-link cubes, using tap-a-shape kits and completing pencil control lines and pictures.

We will be encouraging the children to throw using both an under and over arm technique.

All children will now get to enjoy music and movement as we have added an additional session into our week.

We will be developing our running skills ready for Sports day.



### Literacy

This term our focus texts are Bright Stanley, Sharing a shell and Sandcastle. We will encourage the children to listen to stories and show good attention.

We will talk about what is happening in the story and predict what might happen next.

We will be thinking about the sounds in words and listening carefully to the sounds at beginning of words. We will be spotting words that have the same sounds.

### Expressive Arts and Design



Our focus nursery rhymes for this term

are I'm a pirate, Row, row, row, your boat and one, two, three, four, five once I caught a fish alive.

The children will be engaging in imaginative play in the home corner with added summer enhancements, such as sponge lollipops.

We will be encouraging the children to create and draw expressing their thoughts and ideas creatively.

This term the children will be able to use hammers and small pin nails to hammer into wooden blocks (closely supervised)

### Mathematics

This term we will continue to practice counting with 1:1 correspondence, touching one object for one number name, increasing numbers from 1-5 to 1-10.

We will begin to understand that we find out answers to How many? questions by using counting.

We will be looking at amounts and numerals and linking these two aspects.

We will be encouraging the children to record their mathematical ideas.

We will practise recognising the pattern of small numbers 1-4 and say the number without needing to count.

We will be placing amounts in the right order.

We will be recognising and naming 2d shapes.

### Understanding The world

This term we will be finding out about seaside habitats and the animals that live there.

Children will have the opportunity to create their own underwater and seaside small worlds, using sand, shells, boats and animals.

We will be finding out about pirates and digging for lost treasure.

At wonderful wellies we will be looking at the changing seasons and comparing the trees now to pictures we took in November and December.

Through books and pictures we will continue to develop our understanding of the differences between people and recognising what makes each of us special.

### Personal, Social and Emotional Development

Children will be encouraged to put on their own coats and we will show them strategies they can use. We will encourage the children to say 'help me please.'

We are working hard on manners and encouraging and praising children to remember to say please and thank you.

We will continue to work on actions and consequences and remind children to use kind hands, kind words and kind feet when they are playing.

We will be looking at similarities and differences between people and begin to understand that we all have our individual talents.
