



Duplo barrier game instructions

You will need: six bricks - a big and little red, blue and yellow brick

- Firstly, give your child one of the photos and explain they have to use their bricks to make the same model
- Once they can do this, explain that you are going to make the game more difficult.
- This time you are going to choose a photo and not show it to them. You are going to tell them what to do and they have to do their best listening.
- Give the instructions one at a time. For example, “put the big red brick down first. Then put the little blue brick on top in the middle. Last put the big yellow brick on the top”.
- You have a range of models to choose from – some easy, and some which require more difficult instructions!
- When they have finished their model, compare it with your photo to see if they are the same.
- Finally see if you can reverse roles. Tell them they are going to be the teacher.
- Explain they have to choose a photo, they can't show it to you but they have to tell you what to do to help you make the model.
