If your application is successful, your child may be eligible for:

- Further teaching intervention / well-being support
- Priority access to clubs

Subsidised Breakfast Club places

- Additional enrichment activities
- Free School Meals

If you think you may be entitled to Free School Meals, please visit the parent portal link below. Even if your child is currently receiving Universal Free School Meals (EYFS, Year 1 & 2 children) or bringing their own lunch, this portal is the only way that the school can receive additional Pupil Premium funding for your child.
