Children earn Dojo points and receive a certificate at 50 points, a coloured badge at 100 points, and a gold badge at 150 points



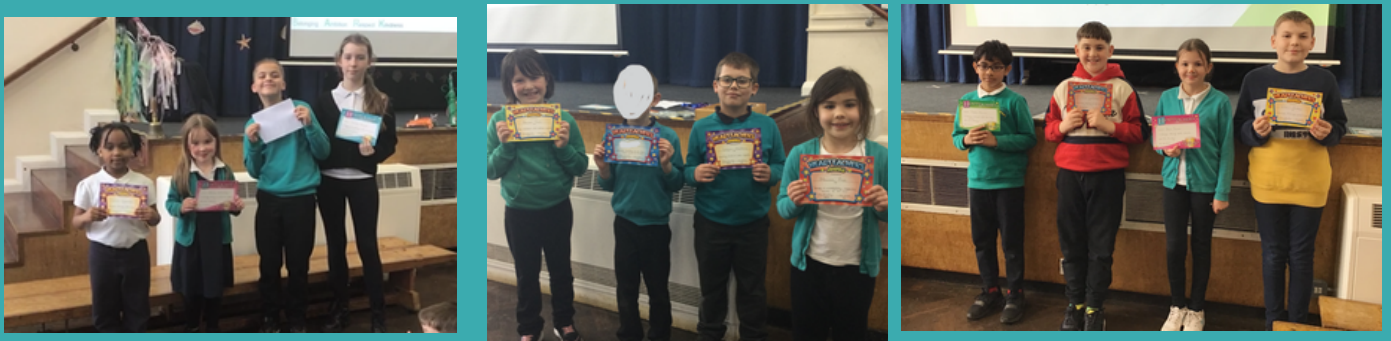
## Stars that Shine

## Living our school Values

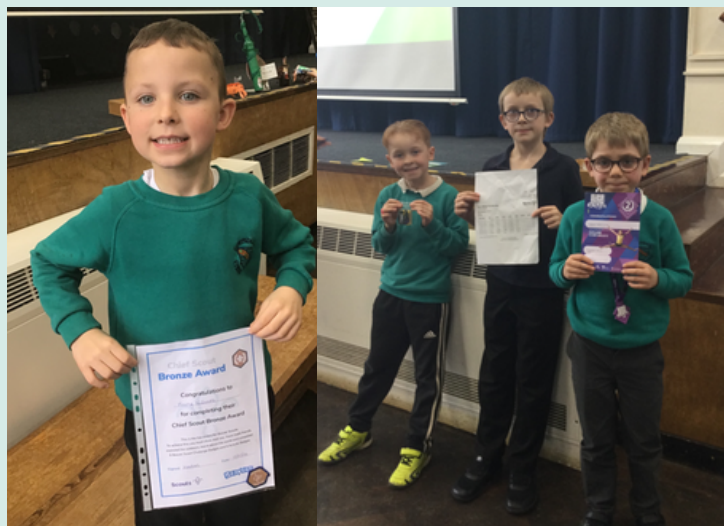
These children have been nominated for demonstrating our school values of belonging, ambition, respect, and kindness.
